Meeting was called to order by Chairman Dan King.

Clerk's report was presented, motion was made by Bruce Paulsen to approve, Mark Johnson seconded the motion: motion carried.

Treasurer's report was presented, motion was made by Mark Johnson to approve, Bruce Paulsen seconded the motion: Motion carried

Town Board along with Bob Pardun approved the following dates:

Polk county presented the Trade River Bridge project on County Road B. Jacob Friberg with Cooper engineering explained the project. The state will fund 80% with the county funding 20%. The project will start after June 15th, 2023, costing between \$250,000 to \$400,000 to replace.

Cushing Fire Department made a presentation on defibulator purchase proposing 2 units one for upstairs and one for the main floor.

Open forum had 6 community members speak

Bruce Paulsen wanted some wording changed on the wording of the Livestock operations ordinance.

Bruce Paulsen made a motion to keep moratorium on until the CAFO ordinance is passed and the application for the ordinance is complete. Mark Johnson seconded the motion. Bruce Paulsen and Mark Johnson voted in favor; Dan King voted No motion passed.

Road report was presented by Dan King on behalf of Chris Bartlett. Chris stated the decision has not yet been made to fix the grader. Chris Bartlett ordered more signs, costing \$524.00
