Lisa Doerr gave an update on the Livestock Operations Ordinance meeting. Waiting to hear back from the committee members, then it will be forwarded onto the lawyers. Trade Lake passed their Ordinance on March 10th. Spent about \$750.00 on lawyers' fees.

Open Forum had 12 community member comments on opposing the Livestock ordinance and questioning the legality of it. The board received a response from the Town's lawyer just today and have not had a chance to review it. They will be keeping it confidential in case it goes to court. The Ordinance has not been tested in court. Lisa Doerr stated 3 Wisconsin statutes that the ordinance is based on.

Livestock Operations Ordinance application form was not ready.

Livestock Citing Ordinance was passed last month and the board signed that ordinance tonight.
