Board meeting minutes
April 19, 2022

Chairman Dan King called the meeting to order at 7:32P.M. All members were present

Clerks report was presented: Bruce Paulson made a motion to approve the minutes. Mark Johnson seconded the motion: Motion carried

Treasurers report was presented: Mark Johnson made a motion to approve the report. Bruce Paulson seconded the motion: Motion carried.

Three community members spoke during open forum.

Road report was given by Chris Bartlett.

The grader has been fixed.

Roads are still to wet to grade.

The culvert on 256th will be replaced and possibly on 235th there is a sinkhole by culvert.

Waiting on the phone company to mark fiber lines on 235th. Once those are marked he will begin ditching and continue with tree trimming.

The side arm on the mower has been fixed.

Chris needs about 4000 tons of gravel for the upcoming year as 210th needs shoulders graveled also.

Cost for the 4000 tons is \$7.00 per ton and \$4.50 per ton to use equipment for a total of \$46,000.00. Which was approved by the town board.

By partisan grant is due by June 3rd, which will require a 5 year plan that Chris will provide. Discussion on 220th street always being an issue.

Jill Cook reported that there is a CD due 4/30/2022. She reported that the rates may increase in May and requested that it be extended for 1 month to see what is happening with rates at that time. Mark Johnson made a motion to extend the CD for 1 month. Bruce Paulson seconded the motion: Motion carried.
