Chairman Dan King called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. all board members present.

Chris Bartlett gave the road report for the town. Lots of snowplowing in the last couple of weeks, with all the recent snow storms. Chris needs to replace a mirror on the truck and has one coming in. Parttime employee Dean Johnson and Chris will be working with the town of Sterling to clear out the snow piles in Cushing tomorrow. The 1 ton has a bad starter and Chris will work at replacing that at his place this week. Both plow trucks have broken windshields and he will be getting those replaced. There has been a few people who have ordered fire # signs already, he will keep that open until February and then place the order for the new signs.

Bills were presented and approved for payment. Correspondence was discussed, and it was decided that the machinery fund CD at US Bank will be rolled into an 11 month CD.
